## **RESOLUTION OF THE ARKANSAS ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL IN SUPPORT OF ISSUE 1**

**WHEREAS**, the Arkansas Economic Development Council is comprised of sixteen commissioners representing many geographic regions of Arkansas. The Commissioners represent a broad spectrum of businesses in Arkansas and serve as advisors to promote economic development within the state; and

**WHEREAS**, the Arkansas General Assembly has referred a proposed constitutional amendment, commonly referred to as "Issue 1," to be considered by the voters of Arkansas at the November 3, 2020 general election; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of Issue 1 is to continue a levy of a one-half percent sales and use tax for state highways and bridges; county roads, bridges, and other surface transportation after the retirement of the bonds authorized in Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 91.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Commissioners of the Arkansas Economic Development Council find that:

- 1. Issue 1 is not a new tax on Arkansans, but is merely a continuation of an existing tax previously approved by Arkansas voters;
- 2. The passage of Issue 1 will benefit every Arkansan's ability to travel safely on our state highways, county roads, and city streets;
- 3. The efficient movement of individuals, goods, and services is vital to every segment of our state's economy;
- 4. The passage of Issue 1 will expedite and continue road construction projects that grow our economy and provide opportunities for Arkansans; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Commissioners hereby unanimously and unreservedly express their support for Issue 1 and encourage its passage by Arkansas voters.
